

Notice from MCCC – Government’s guidance from 13 June, 2020

The government has recently made announcements about two things:

- From 13 June, if there is only **one adult** in your home, you can expand your support network so that it includes **one other household** of any size. This is called ‘forming a **support bubble**’. (This applies to residents in England.)
- From 15 June, places of worship could reopen for **individual private prayer** (*not Sunday Service or any other church activities*). Social distancing still applies.

Support Bubble

From 13 June, if you live by yourself or are a single parent with dependent children, you are able to meet one other household with fewer restrictions. For example, you are allowed to:

- Go indoors or outdoors with your support bubble
- Be less than 2m apart from them
- Stay overnight at their place as you could if they were members of your own household

Please note that you **may not change the household of your support bubble** once you have decided who you are going to form a bubble with.

Households with more than one adult:

If neither you or another household are in a single adult household, then you **may not** form a support bubble with one another.

People who have been identified as clinically extremely vulnerable (shielding):

Even if you live alone, the government still advises you **not** to form a household bubble. You should continue to shield and stay 2 metres apart from others, including those you live with.

If someone in your support bubble shows symptoms:

From 13 June, if someone in your household or the household of your support bubble shows coronavirus symptoms, everyone in the support bubble should stay home and isolate for at least 7 days.

Individual Private Prayer

From 15 June, although our centre at Whalley Range could reopen for individual private prayer, we are not able to hold any Sunday Services at the centre yet due to the existing lockdown restrictions.
